4. Regulation Number 7 and Regulation Number 22 The Division will request that the Commission set a hearing to consider separating Regulations Numbers 7 and 22. This would be completed by maintaining parts of Regulation Number 7 as such and establishing new regulations: Part B becomes Regulation Number 24; Part C becomes Regulation Number 25; and Part E becomes Regulation Number 26. The upstream oil and gas intensity and midstream combustion program provisions currently in Regulation Number 22 would be moved to Regulation Number 7. The manufacturing sector greenhouse gas provisions in Regulation Number 22 would become a new Regulation Number 27. The proposed revisions will also include formatting changes. 5. Regulation Number 3

The Division will request that the Commission set a hearing to consider revisions to Regulation Number 3, to establish enhanced modeling, monitoring and permitting requirements for stationary sources in disproportionately impacted communities, in response to HB21-1266.

The Division will request that the Commission set a hearing to consider establishing a new Regulation Number 28 to address greenhouse gases in terms of building energy efficiency in response to HB19-1261 and HB21-1286.
