



## **ARPA Direct Award Timeline**

#### Task Force Project Work

- •Not a first come first serve process
- Moving projects forward, consider effect on the amount available for all projects - cannot spend more than \$113M
- Strategic process for projects - to be developed/funded at a later stage in the process
- Investigate other funding sources





## Background

- Two locations were selected in Arvada and Lakewood.
- Intended for centralized services for people experiencing homelessness or at imminent risk of homelessness.

## **Update**

- DOLA issued an RFP for Regional Navigation Center funding
- Lakewood is still underway with site selection
- Arvada is evaluating need and possible strategies

## **Planning**

- Process is expected to take longer than ARPA timeline.
- Recommend using an allowable use mechanism to extend the timeline.
