Issue: The Board of County Commissioners (BCC) is a party to a Colorado Regional Opioid Intergovernmental Agreement for Region 10, which established the Region 10 Opioid Regional Council, also known as the Gateway to the Rockies Opioid Council or “GROC.” As a member of GROC, the County is responsible for appointing several voting members of GROC.

Background: The BCC is to appoint to GROC (1) a county representative, (2) a city representative, (3) a public health representative, (4) a human services department representative, and (5) a law enforcement representative.

In addition, the County is to vote to approve a nominated court system representative and alternate.
